



# The Bethel Education Foundation Scholarship will award two \$2,500 scholarships.

## **Applicants must:**

- To help fund college costs for two students from the Bethel High School Class of 2012 who need financial assistance in order to further their education at an accredited 4-year college or university.
- Have demonstrated solid academic achievement in a college-preparatory curriculum.
- Demonstrate traits of high personal character. Student should have a record of community service.
- Be a resident of Bethel, CT

## **Required:**

- Official transcript and unofficial test scores (SAT/ACT)
- 2 letters of recommendation (teacher, administrator, coach, employer)
- List of your academic honors, extracurricular activities/clubs, community service, etc.
- Include a personal statement (1-2 pages) explaining why you feel you deserve to be awarded the Bethel Education Foundation Scholarship. Please refer to the criteria above and include any other relevant information about your community involvement.
- Note: Final candidates will be required to complete a survey detailing what percentage of their college costs was paid for by the Bethel Education Scholarship and what other scholarships/awards, if any, they received.

## **Deadline:**

- Applications must be turned into the BHS no later than Friday, March 30, 2012. A BEF representative will pick up completed applications from the Guidance Office on Friday, April 13<sup>th</sup>.

## **Award:**

- Winners' names will be announced at Scholarship Night on May 31st. Upon receipt of the required survey as noted above, a check for \$2,500 will be paid via check directly to the accredited institution in which the student enrolls. Scholarship funds will not be paid directly, nor reimbursed, to an award recipient.

This scholarship is non-renewable. Employees or family members of an employee of AT&T, their spouses, ancestors, children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren or the spouses of their children, grandchildren, or great-grandchildren are not eligible.
